Day 1: Arrivals & Welcome Dinner

Day 2: Casablanca to Rabat

With our tour guide leading the way, we dive straight into the architectural jaw-dropper of the Hassan II Mosque, perched boldly over the Atlantic. Take in its towering minaret and endless tilework.

Then we shift gears and cruise over to Corniche, Casablanca's breezy coastline lined with palms, cafés, and street life that hums with energy.

Next up – Rabat. Walking the streets of Rabat feels like stepping into a living tapestry—woven with centuries-old stone, ocean mist, and a rhythm that hums with quiet power. As Morocco's capital, Rabat balances elegance with edge.

Our local tour guide fills us in on the history of the Hassan Tower and we wander the streets of Kasbah of the Oudayas, a fortified 12th-century citadel perched above the Bou Regreg River. Step through the monumental Bab Oudaia gate—its horseshoe arch carved with floral motifs and Qur'anic verses—and enter a world of whitewashed walls, cobalt blue doors, and winding alleys that feel like a dream in motion. Originally built as a military fortress, the kasbah's thick ramparts and strategic hilltop location once guarded the river mouth and the ancient city of Sala Colonia.

Day 3: Rabat to Chefchaouen

The morning is yours. Spend it soaking in the beautiful intricate details of our Riad or take to the streets to wander before we head to the Blue Pearl of Morocco – Chefchaouen.

Upon arrival, the labyrinthine of city streets feels as though you've wandered into an enchanted fairytale—where sapphire walls and cobalt stairways lead to hidden wonders untouched by time. Our guide tells stories of this enchanting town while we visit the highlights.

As the day winds down, we'll follow our local hosts up into the hills above the Blue City. The trek is gentle, but the reward is unforgettable: a sweeping view of Chefchaouen glowing in every shade of blue as the sun begins to set. Together, we'll prepare a traditional Moroccan feast. When evening falls, we'll dine under the open sky, the city twinkling below us like a dream.

Day 4: Volubilis, Meknes & Fes

On our route to Fes, we take a detour to stroll through the ancient Roman ruins of Volubilis—a remarkably preserved UNESCO World Heritage site that feels frozen in time. Next up is Meknes, the monumental Ismaili capital: marvel at the soaring arches of Bab Al-Mansour, the pools of Sahrij Souani Basin, the solemn grandeur of Moulay Ismail’s Mausoleum, and the massive Royal Stables that once housed thousands of horses.

Upon arrival in Fes, with our local guide leading the way, we’ll dive into centuries-old tanneries and watch artisans spin handwoven carpets and forge intricate metalwork using techniques passed down through generations.

Day 5: Fes – Ifrane – Cedars Forest – Midelt – Ziz Valley & Sunset Camel Rides in the Sahara

We head south from Fes to Ifrane, Morocco’s alpine town with chalet-style charm. Stop in the cedar forest to meet Barbary macaques—curious, shaggy primates native to North Africa. Continue to Midelt for lunch, then take in sweeping views of the Ziz Valley. Arrive in Merzouga, mount camels into the Sahara, watch sunset from a dune, and settle into your luxe desert camp with Berber music and a desert sky alive with stars.

Day 6: Sahara Desert Adventures

We hop into our 4x4’s across the Sahara, kicking up dust toward a nomad tent built for the raw of the Sahara. Inside, we’re welcomed by the local nomads and greeted with mint tea and stories.


Khamlia hits next. Gnaoua drums slam and we are moved by the rhythm of their beat. This is a full-body experience and you’re part of it.

We test our luck spotting flamingos at a desert lake. Even if we can’t catch these exotic birds, the journey is still worth it. We slow things down and retreat from the Sahara to its palm tree groves.

Day 7: Todgha Gorge Awaits & Desert Drama Meets Cinematic Majesty

And now we climb. Todgha Gorge isn't just dramatic—it's vertical. With our trusted climbing guide leading the way, we grip the wall, trust the rope, and earn the view. *Included, but optional activity. However, you won't want to miss the epic views from this angle.

Next up - Ait Ben Haddou, a UNESCO-listed ksar that looks like it was carved straight out of a movie set—because it was. Gladiator, Game of Thrones, The Mummy... they all filmed here. It's a real mudbrick fortress, stacked into the hillside, with winding alleys, crumbling towers, and breathtaking panoramic views.


Onward to Marrakech - Our guide takes us through the labyrinthine medina and we slip into our intricately tiled riad. Unwind from the day in our plunge pool or sip mint tea while wandering the mosaic-laced corridors of our Riad.

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Mosque. We wander through the halls of Ben Youssef Quranic Mosque to uncover tucked away splendor. Your guide will help you gain confidence navigating the labyrinthine streets of the Medina and bring Marrakech's rich history to life.

As the sun sets, dive into the electrifying energy of the night market, where sizzling street food, hypnotic music, and dazzling lights create an unforgettable spectacle.

Day 9: Marrakech Uncovered

This morning, awaken to the soothing ritual of a traditional hammam—a centuries-old cleansing experience that is both rejuvenating and deeply cultural. Begin in the warm steam room, where the heat opens your pores and relaxes your muscles. Then, indulge in an invigorating black soap scrub, followed by a vigorous exfoliation with a kessa mitt, leaving your skin silky smooth. As warm water is poured over you in rhythmic motions, the experience becomes almost meditative, washing away stress and fatigue. Unwind with the soothing sound of trickling water, fragrant mint tea, and delicate Moroccan cookies—a perfect moment of relaxation before stepping back into the vibrant rhythm of Marrakech.

We are greeted by Moroccan hospitality as a local family welcomes us into their home with open arms. Before the cooking begins, we will select the freshest ingredients from the bustling souks. Back in the family's cozy kitchen, their warm guidance unfolds, as we learn to master the art of tajine cooking, a time-honored technique that infuses dishes with deep, layered flavors. As the tagine simmers over a slow flame, filling the air with the rich aroma of stewed meats and spices, our hosts share stories.

The rest of the day is yours—wander souks, relax poolside, or explore Marrakech's winding streets and local vendors.

Day 10: Atlas Mountains Await: Hikes, Homestays & Time-Honored Traditions

We'll head into the heart of the High Atlas Mountains, where jagged peaks and quiet valleys set the stage for a slower, deeper kind of adventure. With a local guide leading the way, we'll explore scenic trails that wind through walnut groves, terraced fields, and Berber villages tucked into the hillsides.

As the sun dips behind the mountains, we'll arrive in Imlil, a peaceful village perched at the base of Mount Toubkal. Here, we'll settle into a traditional homestay, where the views are endless and the hospitality is heartfelt. Dinner is homecooked and soul-warming—think tagine simmered with local spices, fresh bread, and mint tea shared under a sky full of stars. This isn't just a stop—it's a chance to connect with the land, the people, and the rhythm of Berber life. The Amazigh communities of Imlil have called these mountains home for generations, preserving traditions shaped by both landscape and legacy. We're welcomed not as tourists, but as guests—invited into their homes, their kitchens, and their stories. Over shared meals and warm Qahwa Ma'atra (spiced Moroccan coffee), we witness customs passed down through centuries, rooted in simplicity, resilience, and deep respect for the earth.
