Day 2: Mayan Exploration to Ocean Vibes

At your leisure, make your way to the hotel's breakfast area to enjoy your included morning meal before the day begins. We meet the group in the hotel lobby — our first adventure awaits.

We start our morning surrounded by lush jungle, where ancient plazas and ceremonial temples whisper stories of Mayan kings and cosmic rituals. With our expert local guide leading the way, we explore the ancient city of **Altun Ha** — home to the famous Jade Head and some of Belize's most important archaeological treasures. Expect gentle climbs to temple tops, jungle sounds echoing through the ruins, and a vivid dive into centuries of history and myth.

After a morning of exploration, we make our way to the coast and board a water taxi bound for our next destination — and the highlight of the trip — **Caye Caulker**. Here, bikes and golf carts rule the road, reggae drifts through the air, and the sea breeze invites you to slow down and settle into island life.

As the sun begins to set, we'll gather for dinner overlooking the ocean — your first taste of Caye Caulker's laid-back charm. Fresh lobster, grilled snapper, and Belizean stew chicken are just a few of the local favorites waiting for you at one of the island's colorful beachside spots.

 - Cheerful beachfront spot with smoothie bowls, fresh juices, and gluten-free bread.
 - *Gluten-free friendly:* Staff are celiac-aware and offer GF bread and desserts.
- **Errollyn's House of Fry Jacks- Opens at 6:30am**
 - Iconic local stand for Belize's famous stuffed fry jacks (beans, eggs, chicken).

- **Reef Exploration** Snorkel among vibrant coral reefs alive with colorful tropical fish.
- **Shark & Ray Encounters** Take your chances swimming alongside gentle nurse sharks and glide through *Ray Alley*, where stingrays gather gracefully.
- **Snorkeling Support** Our friendly catamaran staff will guide beginners with clear snorkeling instructions, ensuring everyone feels confident in the water. Participation is optional — you can simply relax onboard if you prefer.
- **Onboard Dining** After the adventure, we anchor in calm waters to enjoy freshly prepared shrimp ceviche, paired with a celebratory rum punch toast.
- **Return to Caye Caulker** We dock back at 1:00 PM, giving you the afternoon to unwind. Relax by the pool, explore local hot spots, or simply soak in the island vibe.
