Day 3: Cinque Terre: Coastal Trails & Colorful Dreams

We'll all start the morning together in the first village before splitting into two relaxed, scenic options: a shorter coastal hike paired with train travel between villages, or a breezy boat tour along the coastline. Both offer incredible views, delicious food stops, and plenty of time to explore.

 Option 1: Scenic Coastal Hike + Train Between Villages

Commitment Level: Moderate | 1.5–2 hours of hiking

This is the perfect way to experience Cinque Terre's famous trails without committing to a full-day trek. We'll hike one of the most beautiful sections of the Blue Trail—typically Corniglia → Vernazza or Vernazza → Monterosso—giving you iconic cliffside views, colorful villages, and Mediterranean landscapes.

After the hike, we'll use the Cinque Terre train to hop between the remaining villages, giving you time to wander, shop, swim, or enjoy a long seaside lunch.
